# Water and Education Needs in Sierra Leone: How Boise Can Help

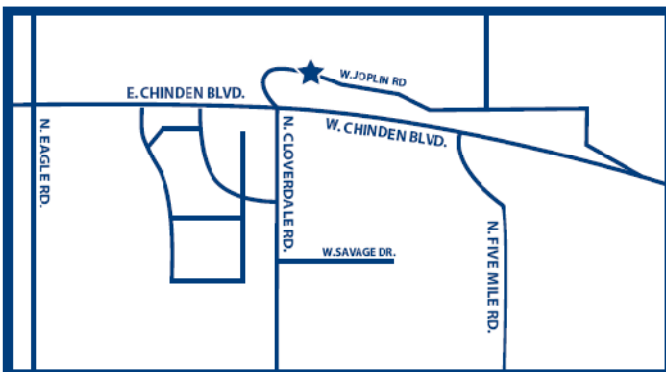
